**ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR RECIPIENTS OF GREATER KANSAS CITY ART ASSOCIATION
\$500 SCHOLARSHIP FINE ART AWARD**

1. Applicant must be a high school senior, or above, enrolling as a collegiate fine art major.
2. Former GKCAA scholarship applicants and recipients may reapply.
3. Applicants may not be related to GKCAA members.
4. Statement of purpose letter written by student, including name, address and telephone number.
5. Copy of current school transcript.
6. Two letters of recommendation from teachers; at least one letter must be from an art teacher.
7. GKCAA Application Check list completely filled out.
8. Three pieces of original art work. ATTENTION! At this time GKCAA defines fine art as all forms of painting, drawing and sculpture. Photography is not currently accepted. Submit 1 set of the following:
 - A) 3 slides (35mm) of original art work, 1 slide for each piece (PREFERRED METHOD)
 - B) 3 5" x 7" photos of original art work, 1 photo for each piece, not digitally enhanced
 - C) CD containing JPG file, 300DPI, showing 3 original art works, not digitally enhanced
 - D) 3 original art works, contact Scholarship Chairman for instructions regarding this method. Slides, CDs, photographs or original art work's must be clearly signed and each piece labeled with artist's name, title of work, medium and finished image size.
